SINGAPORE: The Young Men's Christian Association (YMCA) of Singapore announced on Friday (Jun 19) that it elected a new president, Mr Chew Kwee San, following its Annual General Meeting on May 28.

In a press release, YMCA said Mr Chew "brings with him a wealth of experience from both the corporate and social service sectors".

Mr Chew, 46, has been a YMCA volunteer since 1999 and is currently a member of the National Council of YMCAs of Singapore. Mr Chew also serves on the board of the National Council of Social Service and is one of the three vice-chairmen on the Community Chest Committee.
